STAINED GLASS WINDOWS

SOUTH CLERESTORY

These four panels in antique glass and lead are inspired by four Old Testament texts. (From left to right):

Panel 1. Psalm 23. THE LORD IS MY SHEPHERD

The Psalm is illustrated verse by verse.



Panel 2. Isaiah 6, verses 6-8. THE LORD IS HOLY

Isaiah, having set eyes on the Lord, is fearful. One of the Seraphim touches his lips with a burning coal to take away his iniquity. (Note the ordinary people unaware of the Seraphim.) On the right of the panel Isaiah stands and answers the Lord, "Here am I, send me."



Panel 3. Exodus 19, verses 14-20. THE LORD THE LAW-MAKER

Moses tells the people to stay at the foot of Mount Sinai to wash their clothes. Then Moses climbs the mountain to receive the Law.



Panel 4. Samuel 17, verses 47-48. THE LORD IS MIGHTY

The might of God is in the small but vital David against the immovable and stupid Goliath.

NORTH CLERESTORY

Again in antique glass, these panels illustrate four of Christ's parables. (From left to right)

Panel 1. Matthew 13, verses 3-8. "A SOWER WENT FORTH TO SOW". Note flora and the hoopoe bird.



Panel 2. Matthew 13, verses 24-30. SORTING THE GOOD GRAIN AND BURNING THE TARES.



Panel 3. Luke 13, verses 6-9. THE FIG TREE IN A VINEYARD. It is not cut down but given another chance to bear fruit.



Panel 4. Matthew 13, verses 47-48. GATHERING THE GOOD FISH and throwing the worthless ones back is likened to the Kingdom of Heaven
