Our sermon series continues on 2 Timothy. In prior chapters, Paul has encouraged Timothy through an appeal to his lifelong spiritual heritage. He has also instructed Timothy to remain focused on the work of God, rather than pointless bickering. Here in Chapter 3:1-10, Paul will present more warnings about the attitude of false teachers and those who reject God in favour of their own preferences. *"There will be terrible times in the last days"*. Christians need to be prepared for the hardship and suffering associated with these last days. Just as he taught previously, Paul warns Timothy in no uncertain terms to avoid these behaviours and those who participate in them.
